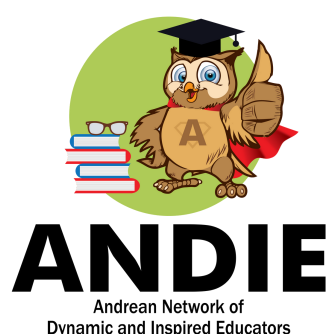
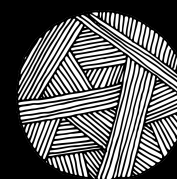


Re:waste - how Sweden is rethinking resources

An estimated two billion tonnes of municipal waste were generated globally in 2016, and according to projections from the World Bank, this number is expected to increase by 70 percent before 2050.

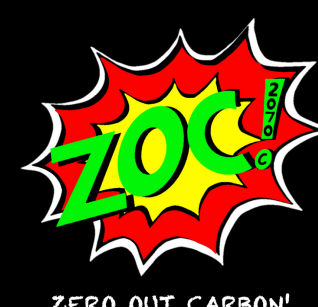
